Financial Assistance:

- Limited financial assistance is available. We accept payments from the ASPIRE and Child Care Subsidy (CCSP) programs through the Dept. of Health & Human Services. We have a cap on the number of slots available for state & FLCP funding. For the 2021-2022 program year, all of these slots are taken by current families.
- Sibling discounts of 15% are also available if a sibling is attending one of our other programs. The discount applies to the lower tuition and the combined tuition amount is rounded to whole dollars.
