**Campers entering grades 1-5** enjoy a full range of summer experiences including hiking, games, crafts, nature study, swimming, sports, and the arts. We offer field trips to area beaches, parks and other places of local interest. Weekly themes bring a focus and thrill to our camp!

Our Purple Group, **for those entering grades 6-8**, will enjoy all that is mentioned above as well as expanded activities to increase personal confidence, peer trust and support. Campers in this group may help with afternoon activities for the week.

## **Our Staff**

- Many staff members have worked in the day camp for more than five years and have trained in the CIT program at First Lutheran.
- They are selected for their experience, training and knowledge in the fields of camping, education and youth leadership.
- Staff is carefully screened for employment and certified in First Aid, CPR and DHHS water safety.
- A low counselor to camper ratio allows for a more individualized experience for the campers.

#### **Schedule Changes and Withdrawals**

Once camp begins, we will not accept new enrollments/registrations.

ADMISSION IS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS AND WILL BE PROVIDED REGARDLESS OF RACE, SEX, AGE, COLOR, NATIONAL ORIGIN OR HANDICAPPING CONDITION.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: We accept Child Care Subsidy and ASPIRE funding through the Department of Health & Human Services. Due to low state reimbursement rates, CCSP and ASPIRE spots are capped per week and eligibility is on a first comefirst served basis.

#### Payments are due as follows:

- For those registered for <u>all nine weeks</u> of day camp: Payment is due weekly, on the Friday prior to the week of attendance.
- For those registered for less than all nine weeks of day camp, payment is due on the following Fridays:

   Payment for Weeks 3 & 4 is due on May 30
   Payment for Weeks 5 & 6 is due on June 15
- Payment via our online Portal or Checks and Money Orders (payable to First Lutheran Day Camp). NO CASH ACCEPTED.

Payment for Weeks 7 - 9 is due on June 30
